When the United Hospital EMS Team began this program of commendation for our system's responders participating in a successful resuscitation of a cardiac arrest victim some were skeptical. Most police officers, firefighters, and EMTs resist the proverbial spotlight. They go into this line of work not for praise or public recognition but instead to better their communities, help people at their most vulnerable, and then fade into the background.

Every so often, though, I'm sure you would all agree, it is important that we actually show appreciation, prove our admiration, and support these men and women in the way they deserve.

On the evening of March 12th, 2016 some of these same providers responded to a call for a man down. As the ambulance and engine companies arrived they initiated life-saving interventions that ultimately saved a 33-year-old man. He can participate in family activities, enjoy his friends, perform work duties, and simply experience the world.
