RE: 2020 Paving Project-Mapleridge Subdivision

Dear Property Owner,

The Village of Somers is extending an invitation to the residents of the Mapleridge Subdivision to attend a Public Information Meeting, immediately following the Board Meeting, at approximately 6:00 PM on Tuesday, July 14, 2020. The purpose of this meeting is to provide residents information regarding the Village of Somers 2020 Paving Project.

Stark Paving will tentatively start the 2020 Paving Project towards the end of July 2020. The Paving Project will concentrate on street improvements in the Mapleridge Subdivision. The impacted area includes 14th Street, 14th Place, 15th Street, 97th Avenue, and 98th Avenue. We have included a map on the back of this letter for your convenience.

Residents will have access to their homes during construction, however, there will be an exception during a short window of time in which Stark Paving will be applying hot asphalt, rolling the asphalt, and waiting for the asphalt to cool and harden. The timeframe for this process will be approximately 30 minutes.

The process for this project is as follows:

- 1.) Asphalt will be pulverized and taken to a gravel like condition.
- 2.) Sanitary manholes will be excavated, raised, and resealed.
- 3.) The pulverized asphalt will be final graded.
- 4.) A base coarse of new asphalt will be applied.
- 5.) A surface coarse of new asphalt will be applied
- 6.) The street gravel shoulders will be reestablished.

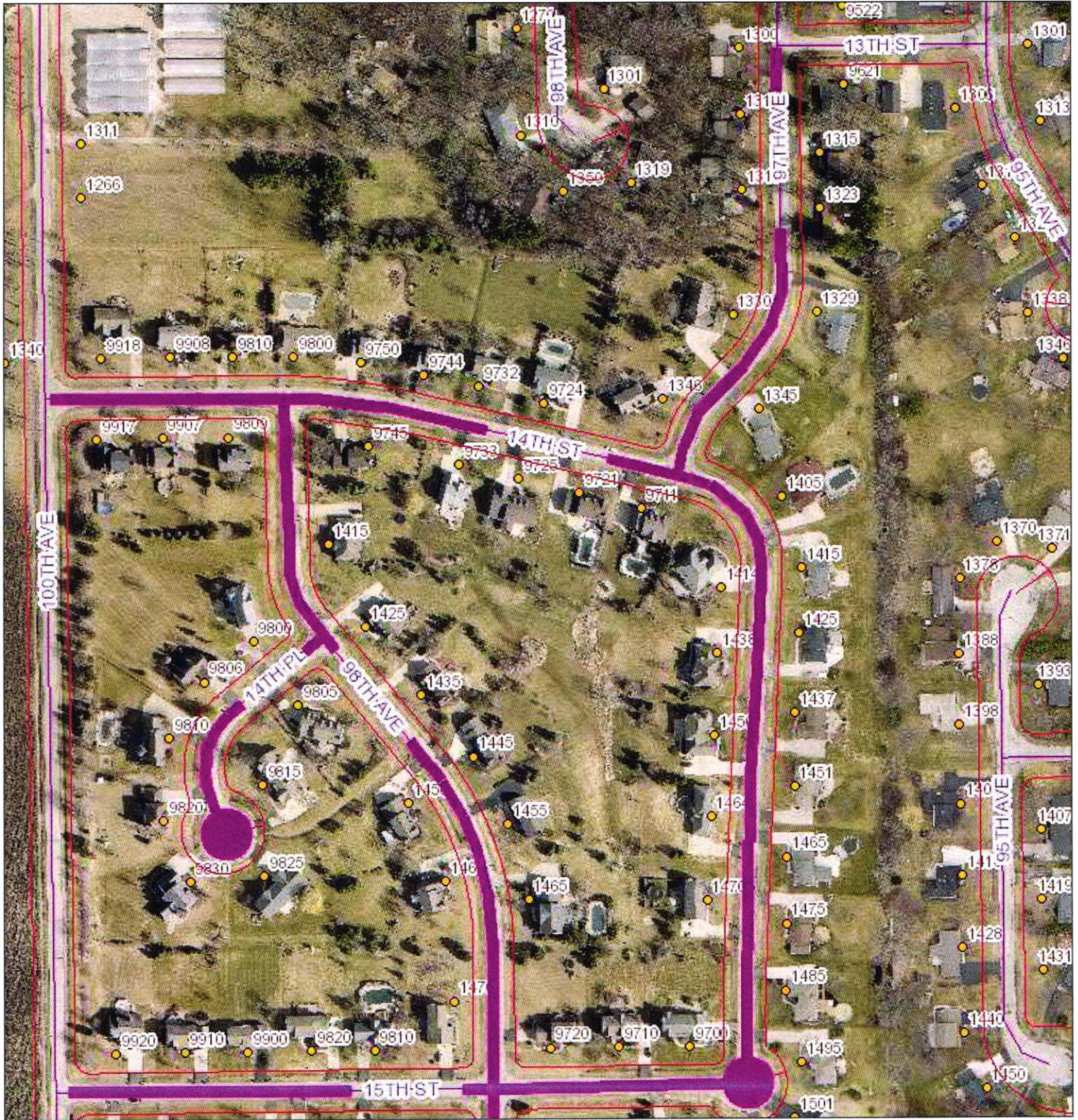
Please note that driveway approaches will be milled back from the roadway. The purpose is to provide for an appropriate amount of distance to allow for the driveway approaches to have a smoothly transition onto the new roadway. We wish to make all residents aware that Stark Paving is not equipped to pave residential driveways, so any inquiries made by residents to have their driveways replaced will be denied.

During construction, residents may experience some dusty conditions, as well uneven road surface, and slightly elevated sanitary sewer manholes. We ask that residents take caution navigating their streets during the construction process.
