RULES

- 1. You must pre-register to participate. NO EXCEPTIONS! Entry form due by JUNE 19!!!**
- 2. You will only be contacted if your entry is NOT accepted, so consider your submission as a confirmation unless contacted. All entries are subject to the discretion of the Somers Parade Committee.**
- 3. Political entries may have immediate family members or no more than two walkers. No campaigning before, during or after the parade.**
- 4. No UTVs are allowed.**
- 5. Show courtesy to all participants and spectators. Safety is our number one priority. No water guns or balloons.**
- 6. Entries should include signage/decorations to support the theme and identify who you are representing on both sides of your vehicle(s).**
- 7. If you're sharing goodies, parade-goers need to stay at least 10 feet away from moving vehicle entries.**

PARADE ROUTE



Staging begins at Noon and ends at 1:20 p.m. at Shoreland Lutheran High School, 9026 12th Street (east entrance only). The Parade starts at 2 p.m. sharp from Shoreland Lutheran High School and proceeds east on 12th Street (Hwy. E), turns south on 72nd Avenue (Hwy EA) and ends at Somers Elementary. It is approximately 1 & ½ miles long. Roads close at noon. Village of Somers or Kenosha County staff will allow parade participants who have pre-registered to proceed to the staging area. Due to our Safety Plan with Kenosha County Sheriff's Dept., Somers Fire & Rescue Department & Somers Public Works, do not arrive from the east after noon.

ALL ENTRIES SHOULD ARRIVE FROM THE WEST DOWN HWY E (12TH ST).
