12th Street watermain project underway

The Village of Somers is extending its water infrastructure to serve Shoreland Lutheran High School's building and site addition. The project will connect a missing link along 12th Street between 100th Avenue and the U.S. Post Office. It is scheduled to be completed by July 4th. Once completed, municipal water service will become available to residents in the heart of Somers and provide more reliable and efficient service throughout the Village. The Fourth of July parade is still planned to take place along the route.

ZIP Code legislative update

The Village of Somers continues its drive to have the U.S. Postal Service grant us a unique ZIP Code. So far, the USPS has denied our requests. We are working with [municipalities from all over the country](#) with the same issue. Seven are right here in Wisconsin. The Village is on four bills in Congress to address the issue ([H.R. 672](#), [H.R. 3095](#), [S. 1455](#) and [S. 2961](#)). A new Bill was just introduced as well: [S. 4505](#) with 75 municipalities. Unfortunately, the Wisconsin municipalities were kept out of the Bill.
