2026 road work

The Village awarded Payne and Dolan the contract to repave the Valley View subdivision. The bid came lower than expected and for the first time, the Village received state funds for road improvement. Work is expected to take start soon.

Development updates

Roers Companies

The multi-family development along the Union Pacific Railroad North of Highway E is coming back for consideration in front of the Plan Commission on July 13. Please check the village website for update.

Savannah at Pike Creek

The first two buildings of the second phase of the project were granted occupancy. The second phase consists of 146 apartments, which is in addition to the 190 existing. When finished, the subdivision will include 336 living units in 53 buildings.

Somers Creek

Utility work has been completed at the new subdivision on the southeast corner of Highway E and Green Bay Road. It will include 57 single-family homes. Bear Development, a local company, plans to have a model home completed before the end of the year.

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
